30th NOSTALGIA DAY CAR SHOW September 29, 2019

The Altamont Cruisers' 30th annual charity fundraiser, Nostalgia Day Car Show, will be held on September 29, 2019 on city streets in downtown Livermore. This event typically attracts well over 5,000 people who come to admire the classic cars on display around Downtown Livermore. The show will be featured locally on radio, in newspapers, and in car-related magazines. Thousands of flyers are distributed throughout the Tri-Valley area and many local businesses help by displaying posters to advertise the event.

You will need to have a City of Livermore business license if you are selling items. This is a requirement of the City of Livermore.

Since this is a family oriented show, there can be no drug, adult, or profane words or pictures displayed on any of your products.

The vendor spaces average a generous 150 square feet and will rent for \$125 each for the one-day show on a first paid, first reserved basis. You will need to have a City of Livermore business license if you are selling items (See attached forms). This is a requirement of the City of Livermore. If you are a returning vendor and your sales are expected to be less than \$5,000, your license will cost \$14. Returning vendors need to call the City of Livermore (925-960-4310) and can renew via telephone.
